1. Minehead Motor Club Ltd will promote an All Forwards Autotest on Sunday 28th July 2024 at Ellicombe near Minehead. Map Ref: 181/984447. The venue is a smooth grass field, and will be nondamaging, therefore suitable for any production car using road pattern tyres.

The venue will be arrowed from the Ellicombe roundabout on the A.39.

2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motor Sports UK, (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations. 3. MSA Clubmans Permit no. TBA. The event is open to all fully elected members of the Minehead Motor Club and the MGCC SW, Club membership cards will be inspected at signing-on. All competitors will **need a RS Clubman License** (which can be obtained free from www.motorsportuk.org)

5. The programme of the meeting will be:

First car starts at 10.00 hrs

Any competitor not ready to start by 10.00 hrs may be excluded

Competitors will be given an opportunity from 09.30hrs to walk the course prior to the first competing car. 6. The event will consist of three classes.

CLASS A - All cars which have been driven to the event, therefore taxed, insured and have an MOT if required by law.

CLASS B- All cars which have been brought to the event on a trailer or towed with an A frame.. These cars do not need to be taxed, insured or have an MOT to enter this class.

CLASS C- Any 4WD car, either driven or towed to the event.

All cars must comply with the current Motor Sports UK vehicle and tyre regulations. All vehicles must have a road compliant exhaust system. Please note that "Knobbly" tyres are not permitted. 9. Awards will be presented as follows:

Best in each Class, to be presented at the annual Dinner & Dance, subject to three starters.

13. Details of tests and any final instructions will be issued at signing on. Drivers will have a minimum of four tests with a minimum of two runs at each test all of which will count towards results. Cars will be identified by numbers supplied by the organisers. Timing will be by marshal's hand held stopwatch. Timing will commence on verbal instruction of the marshal at the start of the test.

14. Any competitor or marshal under the age of 18 requires Parental Consent

15. Drivers of age 16, and any driver without a full driving licence, can enter this event, but only in a touring car of less than 1400cc without forced induction.

16. No Passengers Allowed.

17. Any protest must be made in accordance with the 2024 Motorsport Yearbook Section C and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

18. Maximum speed between Tests, 5 mph please!!! Anyone driving or behaving in a reckless manner WILL BE EXCLUDED.

19. Avoid roped off areas. (Goal post sockets)

20. PENALTIES:

a. Jumping the start: Plus 5 seconds.

b. Hitting a cone: Plus 5 seconds per cone.

c. Failing to stop astride finish line: Plus 5 seconds.

d. Wrong route: Slowest time plus 20 seconds.

Note: Clockwise or anti clockwise around cones and course markers must be as shown on the course diagrams. Any deviation from that constitutes Wrong Route!!!
